Nomination Guidelines

The Stan Dyck Memorial Award is not a long service award. It is designed to recognize efforts in the present school year.

- When nominating an advisor, it is useful to mention any and all of the following if they are characteristics of the advisor.
- Gets along well with young people, and provides them with opportunities for growth and experience.
- Has given a great deal of extra time, after school and on weekends.
- Has shown good judgment and guidance during a crisis or problem of some sort (ie. Death caused by drinking and driving, etc.)
- Has defended SADD generally and or students specifically against adults with a negative attitude about SADD.

Based on the nomination information provided, a committee of three senior members of SADD who have been Team SGI Members or Young Speakers, will select one or sometimes more than one of the adult advisors nominated to receive the Stan Dyck Memorial Award.

Each nominated advisor will receive a special pin and the advisor/s selected to receive the award will receive a personal plaque to keep and have their name/s added to the permanent plaque.
