Delegate Fees

(Applicable to both Student Delegates and Advisors)

The following charges are based upon a **PER PERSON** rate, which includes Thursday, Friday and Saturday night accommodation, all conference sessions, all activities and conference meals including Friday/Saturday breakfast, lunch and dinner and Sunday breakfast. Thursday dinner is NOT provided.

All student delegates must have a responsible adult in attendance

Adult advisor delegate fees are the same rate as student delegate fees

Please note: All rooms will be filled to capacity. For example, if you have only 2 male students and you request Quad occupancy, your students will be placed in a room (with two beds) with two male students from another school. If you do not find this scenario suitable for your student's needs, please be sure to book your students into the appropriate type of accommodation, with the appropriate price. It is anticipated that beds will be shared in rooms that are Quad (two beds) or Triple (two beds) occupancy. Cots are not available.
