With more than 20 years of experience as a professional Radio host and Broadcast Journalist

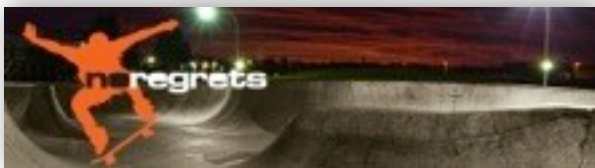
