The purpose of this Scholarship Fund is to provide financial assistance to individuals pursuing a post-secondary education, whose parent, spouse, sister, brother, step-sister, step-brother or guardian has died in a motor vehicle accident involving an impaired driver.

The scholarship available in any year shall be for a minimum of **\$2,500.00 to a maximum of \$15,000.00 yearly**. Applicants must apply annually and may be eligible to receive a scholarship for a maximum of three individual years. Applicants must qualify to be eligible to receive funds from this scholarship, see the Guidelines and Criteria for requirements. Funds are limited and number of scholarships available in any year is dependent upon funds available.

Up to \$11,000.00 available for 2014.

Attention will be given to applicants who are not receiving financial support from other sources.

Applicants who are actively volunteering in charitable activities or associations will be given special consideration.
